



THAI VISA INSTRUCTIONS

1. One application form must be fully completed and submitted together with a valid passport and passport-size photograph.
2. Nationals of some countries are exempted from obtaining a tourist visa provided that their period of stay in Thailand does not exceed 30 days (including the days of arrival and departure) and hold confirmation of outbound tickets prior to entry, within that 30 days. *Persons without confirmed outbound ticket must have a visa.* Please refer to the Consulate for details. **Please note that these exemptions do not apply to visitors from any countries entering Thailand by land, rail, sea or private aircraft, or who visit for business, professional or other non-tourism purposes.**
3. Nationals of Communist, Socialist and some Middle East countries must have a transit visa and are required to submit four photographs, two forms and evidence of confirmed flights into and out of Thailand.
4. Holders of **Certificates of Identity** issued by any country require a visa irrespective of the length of stay. They must also be in possession of confirmed inbound and outbound air tickets, which must be evidenced at the Consulate upon visa application. Four photographs and two application forms are required, together with a Letter of Guarantee and Declaration form.
5. Types of visa (Fees as at August 2003 and subject to change without notice)
 - (a) **TOURIST VISA - \$45.00 per entry**
-Enables a 60-day stay in Thailand (employment, paid or unpaid, is strictly prohibited)
 - (b) **NON-IMMIGRANT VISA - \$90.00 for single entry and \$225.00 for Multiple Entries**
-Enables a 90-day stay. For business, professional education or other non-tourism purposes. A letter from employer, copy of the company's registration certified by authorized director(s). Or a letter from educational institute must be submitted.
A multiple- entry visa is valid for twelve months.
 - (b) **TRANSIT VISA - \$35.00 per entry**
-For issue to certain nationals only; see paragraph 3 above.
-Available to applicants in direct transit to a third country. Not issue for tourism purposes.
6. A one entry visa must be utilised within three months from date of issue. However, additional entries may be granted upon request and at the discretion of Consulate, and payment of the additional fees prescribed, Multiple entry visas must be utilised within six months of the date of issue. **(Other than Non-Immigrant visa. See 5(b) above)**
7. For mail applications, a prepaid self-addressed **Post Office Express** or Registered Post envelope for the return of **EACH** passport must be provided, or a **Prepaid Courier Bag** if preferred. Please ensure that sufficient prepayment is made to enable your passport returned without delay. If a return envelope is not provided, or insufficient postage is not prepaid, the applicant must collect the passport at the Consulate. Personal visa applications can be made at the Consulate between 0930 and 1530 hours daily Monday through Friday (Thai and Australian public holiday Excepted)
8. The passport must be valid for not less than 6 months from the date of arrival into Thailand.
